A new test measuring ROX, your blood's Reserve Oxygen supply, is being evaluated to assess pain levels, which may lead to new pain treatments. You may qualify to participate in this research study. We are looking for study subjects with or without chronic disease who:

- Have essentially no pain, and are taking no pain medications, or
- Experience pain, and are on medications that usually work, or
- Experience pain, and are on medications that mostly don't work.
